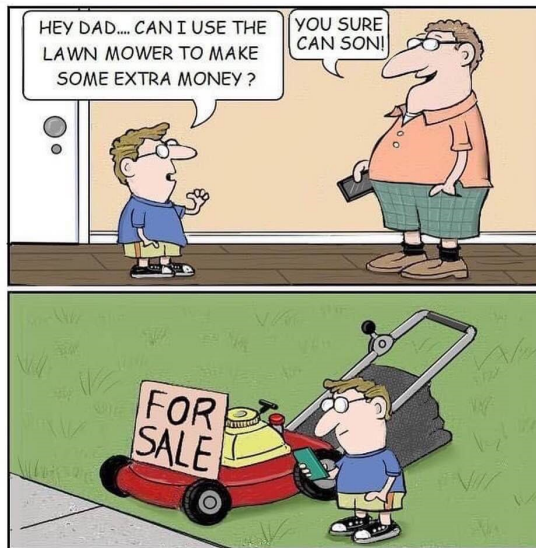

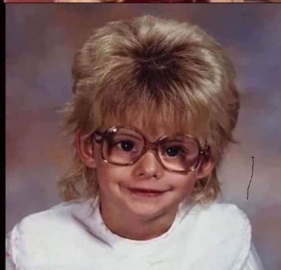

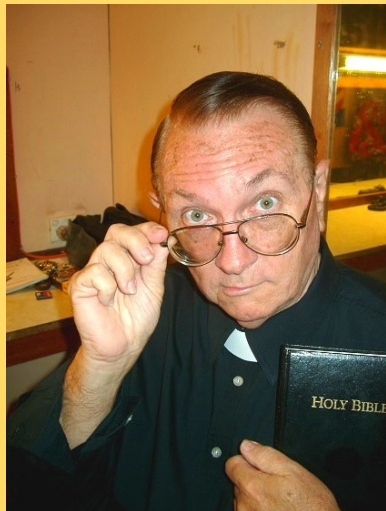

Peter got the acting bug about forty

years ago when he was cajoled into auditioning for a part in the comedy play 'WHO'S ON FIRST ?' with the Act 1 Theatre [before they moved to Strathpine, Circa 1984]. History reveals Peter got the part and has been actively involved in theatre ever since, taking on various theatrical executive roles such as Publicity Officer, Treasurer, Secretary, etc and he is also a Past President of Act 1 Theatre, M.I.T.S. [Mount Isa Theatre society] and the Sandgate Theatre Inc. He has manned the bio box for sound and lighting, designed and built sets, been a dramaturg and directed several plays but now prefers to be on stage, acting in musicals, dramas, comedies, farces, murder mysteries, commedia dell'artes and theatre restaurants [literally too many to count]. Peter won several acting awards in the 1997 Festival Circuit for his role as Morris in Sandgate Theatre's one-act play 'Custodians of Culture', including Best Comedy Actor and Best Dramatic Actor..... for the same role ! Over the years he has acted with several theatre companies, including Mousetrap Theatre, Shoestring Theatre, Edge Theatre Company, Mount Isa Theatre Society, John Wikman Productions, KSP Theatre, Nazlife Productions and of course, Sandgate Theatre Inc. He has used his work retirement productively by acting in numerous university student films as well as several Indie film productions and enjoys being cast as a Simulated Patient, training medical students for the University of Queensland, the Griffith University Hospital Southport, The Royal Brisbane and Womens Hospital, The Catholic University and Griffith University Hospital Sunshine Coast.

Peter is currently enjoying rehearsing for the role of ONSLOW at Sandgate Theatre for their upcoming production of the popular T.V. sitcom 'Keeping up Appearances' which opens in November 2020.
